Memory Verse: Luke 9:35 “This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!”

Reflection Questions

1. God calls us to listen to Jesus. How does God speak to you?
2. When have you been literally or spiritually “to the mountaintop”?
Have you ever had an amazing encounter with God? What was that like for you?
Did you seek to remain there as Peter did?
Were you reluctant or energized to come down from that mountaintop experience?
3. How have you needed Jesus healing presence as the boy who was seizing needed Jesus?
4. When have you felt betrayed? How was God’s presence made known in that experience?
